I am the Manager of a Respite Facility based in Helensburgh for Children and Young people who have both physical and learning disabilities. I have heard that there is a possible proposal for adaptations to the swimming pool which would mean that it would be far more accessible for the young people we support.

Accessible facilities such as changing rooms and any additional space/equipment for supporting individuals to allow them to access the swimming pool would be of huge benefit to the local community, in particular the young people at Ardlui House and in the wider community. Lack of access is a massive barrier for many of the young people who really enjoy taking part in leisure activities such as swimming which has a very positive impact on their health and well being.

I am very interested in hearing more about the plans and both myself and the staff team are excited to see how this develops.
