I grew up in Cour and regularly return to my childhood home to visit my mother and alongside friends and family to enjoy the beauty of Cour Bay. Every visit home includes a trip to the beach with paddling, if not swimming for both dogs and humans!!

I am concerned that I will be exposed to pollution from the fish farm and a harmful dose of organophosphates or other dangerous chemicals.

I therefore **strongly object** to this fish farm.

In addition it does not comply with the Scotland's National Marine Plan, which requires that concentrations of contaminants are at levels not giving rise to pollution effects, the coast, seas, oceans and their resources are safe to use. decision makers should seek to mitigate impacts on the quality of designated bathing waters and areas particularly important for immersion sports from any proposed development.

If this planning application is granted, it needs to go to a judicial review.

I implore you to carefully consider the objections for the fish farm at North Kilbrannan. There are so many areas of Scotlands coast line that are unreachable and that would not be impacted by a fish farm. North Kilbrannan would be tragically affected. Please.
