Hi Fiona,

What has been submitted here is from 2009 and I think has been use many times to demonstrate that the water supplied by the "Ardbrecknish House Supply" (ref AABOL0005) will be sufficient for the properties being developed.

Through various discussions with people, I am aware that there have been issues with the Ardbrecknish House Supply and that it was actually damaged quite badly last Autumn during the bad floods. There was, and probably is, continued discussions about works are going to be undertaken to upgrade the water extraction.

This document (being written in 2009) does of course not include these issues and is relevant for what was seen at the time of writing and so there may additional works required to be done. This will not be just by the applicant though - it is more for the shared users of the "supply".

At this stage, this is satisfactory for the pre-start to works, but prior to occupation we need to know that it is suitable in terms of water quality, with submission of water microbiology and water chemistry results. It is advised that as a minimum there is installation of pre-filtered UV at the applicant's property.

So they are Ok to use the Ardbrecknish House Supply, but works are likely going to be needed by the shared users of the supply. Before occupation, we will be needed proof of suitability in terms of the quality.
